Bus stops close to campus	Yes
Detail of bus stops close to campus	Several bus routes stop by the Grangegorman campus on North Circular Road, or a short walking distance away e.g. on Prussia Street. Main Dublin Bus routes close by include: 46a, 11, 122, 4, 13, 38, 38a, 145, 39, 39a.
Distance to nearest train/Tram station	Luas (Red Line) stop at Smithfield 1km (approx 12 minute walk), going to both Heuston and Connolly stations. Alternatively Heuston Station is approximately a 22 minute walk (1.7km).

Where to buy Leap on-site	In the college restaurant, the Courtyard in Rathdown House
Student Leap cards available close to campus	Yes
Where to buy Leap Cards close to campus	News Value Shop, Park Shopping Centre, Prussia Street (approx 5 minute walk from campus) and Daybreak, New Cabra Road (approx 10 minute walk) sell Leap cards.
